**JOINT MOTION FOR IN-PERSON TRIAL AND, IF NECESSARY, A STATUS
CONFERENCE**

The parties jointly and respectfully request that the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled to commence at 10:00 a.m. on March 27, 2023, be conducted in-person. The parties believe that an in-person trial will allow the Court to best assess the credibility of those witnesses who will be testifying live while freeing up the parties to focus on their respective arguments instead of the logistics of video.

If it would aid the Court, the parties further would like to discuss the feasibility and logistics associated with an in-person trial on or before February 17, 2023. Gaining clarity on whether the evidentiary hearing in this matter will be conducted in-person, as jointly requested, or remotely in advance of the hearing date will assist the parties in better preparing for the upcoming trial. The parties hope that such advance preparation will result in a more efficient proceeding and thereby conserve the Court's time and resources. In making this request, the parties would reserve the right to conduct and submit trial depositions if appropriate and to present the testimony of witnesses in open court via live video testimony where there is good cause and compelling circumstances for doing so and appropriate safeguards are put in place.
