**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION  
OF TIME TO RESPOND TO COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S MOTION TO COMPEL  
PRODUCTION OF DR. MOWREY'S EXPERT-RELATED DOCUMENTS**

On April 5, 2005, Complaint Counsel filed a motion to compel Respondents to produce documents identified on the privilege log of Dr. Mowrey. Also on April 6, 2005, by Order certifying motions to the Commission, these proceedings were stayed. By Commission Order dated June 17, 2005, the stay on these proceedings was lifted.

On June 29, 2005, Respondent Daniel B. Mowrey filed an unopposed motion requesting additional time to respond to Complaint Counsel's motion to compel production of documents from Mowrey. Respondent has demonstrated good cause for the requested extension. Further, Complaint Counsel has agreed to the requested extension. Accordingly, the motion to extend

time is **GRANTED**. Respondent's opposition shall be due on or before July 22, 2005.
