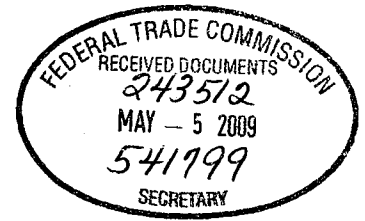

**ORDER ON NON-PARTY THE MOORE COMPANY'S MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SEEK *IN CAMERA* TREATMENT**
