**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION  
FOR FIRST REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER**

On March 13, 2020, Federal Trade Commission (“FTC” or “Commission”) Complaint Counsel and Respondents Axon Enterprise, Inc. and Safariland, LLC filed a Joint Motion for First Revised Scheduling Order (“Joint Motion”). The parties recite that on March 13, 2020, the Commission granted the parties’ Joint Expedited Motion to Reschedule the Administrative Hearing from May 19, 2020 to June 23, 2020, due to delays in conducting depositions. The parties therefore request an extension of the deposition discovery and post-discovery deadlines in the current Scheduling Order by five weeks, in order to align with the new date for the evidentiary hearing. The parties submitted a proposed First Revised Scheduling Order with the Joint Motion.

Pursuant to Rule 3.21(c)(2), the Administrative Law Judge may grant a motion to extend any deadline or time specified in the Scheduling Order, other than the date of the evidentiary hearing, upon a showing of good cause. 16 C.F.R. § 3.21(c)(2). In determining whether to grant the motion, the Administrative Law Judge shall consider, *inter alia*, any extensions already granted, and the need to conclude the evidentiary hearing and render an initial decision in a timely manner. *Id.* Based on the representations in the Joint Motion, the parties have demonstrated good cause for the requested extension. Moreover, this is the parties’ first request to extend a Scheduling Order deadline, and the requested extension will not adversely impact the ability to conclude the evidentiary hearing or to render an initial decision in a timely manner.

Accordingly, the Joint Motion is GRANTED. A First Revised Scheduling Order is being issued concurrently with this order.
