ORDER ON RESPONDENT TRONOX'S THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION FOR IN CAMERA TREATMENT

Pursuant to Rule 3.45(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, on June 12, 2018, Respondent Tronox Limited ("Tronox") filed a Third Supplemental Motion for *In Camera* Treatment ("Third Supplemental Motion"). Federal Trade Commission ("FTC" or "Commission") Complaint Counsel has not filed an opposition to Tronox's Motion.

By Order issued May 15, 2018, Tronox's initial motion for *in camera* treatment was granted ("May 15 Order"). In its Third Supplemental Motion, Tronox explains that it seeks *in camera* treatment for three trial exhibits that were submitted into evidence on May 30, 2018. Tronox explains that each document falls under one of the categories of documents for which it sought and received *in camera* treatment through its initial motion. The legal standards governing the Tronox's Third Supplemental Motion for *in camera* treatment are stated in the May 15 Order.

For the reasons set forth in the May 15 Order, Tronox's Third Supplemental Motion is GRANTED. *In camera* treatment for a period of ten years, to expire on June 1, 2028, is GRANTED for PX1342, RX2005, and RX2006.
