## ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OPPOSITION TO WEBEYECARE'S MOTION TO QUASH

Non-party WebEyeCare filed a Motion to Quash Complaint Counsel's Subpoena on October 14, 2016 ("Motion to Quash"). Complaint Counsel's Opposition to WebEyeCare's Motion to Quash was due October 24, 2016 ("Opposition"). In the instant Motion, filed October 24, 2016, Complaint Counsel seeks an extension of that deadline to October 31, 2016, stating that the parties are in negotiations of the discovery issues raised by WebEyeCare's Motion to Quash and have jointly concluded that additional time for negotiations may yield a resolution of all issues. Complaint Counsel further states that WebEyeCare agrees to the proposed extension.

For the foregoing reasons, Complaint Counsel's Unoppposed Motion for an Extension of Time is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Complaint Counsel's deadline for filing any Opposition to WebEyeCare's Motion to Quash is extended to October 31, 2016.
