THIRD PARTY FREENOME HOLDINGS, INC.'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE FOR *IN CAMERA* TREATMENT OF PROPOSED TRIAL EXHIBITS

Pursuant to 16 C.F.R. §§ 3.22(f) and 4.3(b), Third Party Freenome Holdings, Inc. ("Freenome") respectfully requests a four-day extension of the August 5, 2021 deadline for filing motions for *in camera* treatment of proposed trial exhibits, as set in the Administrative Law Judge's April 26, 2021 Scheduling Order, until Monday, August 9, 2021, for the reasons stated in the Supporting Memorandum below. As required by 16 C.F.R. § 3.22(c), a proposed Order accompanies this Motion.

Supporting Memorandum

On April 26, 2021, the Administrative Law Judge presiding over this matter entered a Scheduling Order setting August 5, 2021, as the deadline for filing motions for *in camera* treatment of proposed trial exhibits. Scheduling Order at 3. In that same Scheduling Order, the Administrative Law Judge also set a deadline of July 26, 2021, for the parties to notify a non-party, such as Freenome, of their intent to offer that non-party's confidential materials as evidence at the hearing. *Id.* This latter deadline implements Commission Rule 3.45(b),

which requires that "[p]arties who seek to use material obtained from a third party subject to confidentiality restrictions . . . demonstrate that the third party has been given at least 10 days notice of the proposed use of such material." 16 C.F.R. § 3.45(b) (emphasis added). See Scheduling Order at 3 n.1.

On July 26, 2021, Freenome received, through the undersigned counsel and via email, notice from Complaint Counsel and counsel for Respondents Illumina, Inc. and GRAIL, Inc., of their respective lists of proposed trial exhibits using testimony and materials that Freenome has designated as confidential pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's March 30, 2021 Protective Order Governing Confidential Material. See Exhibits A and B. Taken together, the testimony and materials from Freenome that the parties intend to use as trial exhibits consist of (1) four transcripts in their entirety – (a) the March 2, 2021 investigational hearing of Michael Nolan (312 pages), (b) the March 4, 2021 investigational hearing of Gabriel Otte (147 pages), (c) the June 1, 2021 deposition of Michael Nolan (310 pages), and (d) the June 24, 2021 deposition of Gabriel Otte (232 pages); and (2) 78 unique documents numbering hundreds of pages.

Although these materials have been collected and reviewed by the undersigned counsel, Freenome has encountered scheduling difficulties within the allotted ten-day window for its CEO, Mr. Michael Nolan, to review and discuss the materials with counsel prior to his signing the required declaration or affidavit explaining the confidential nature of the materials. See *In re 1-800 Contacts, Inc.*, 2017 FTC LEXIS 55 (Apr. 4, 2017); *In re North Texas Specialty Physicians*, 2004 FTC LEXIS 66 (Apr. 23, 2004); Additional Provision 12, Scheduling Order at 6–7 (citing these cases).

Suffice it to say, Freenome duly acknowledges the Administrative Law Judge's strict standards for motions for *in camera* treatment but it needs a little additional time

(specifically, four extra days, including weekend days) in order to properly comply with the requirements. Importantly, it does not have internal legal staff to assist with the preparation of its motion for *in camera* treatment and instead must rely exclusively on the coordinated efforts of its outside counsel and its CEO, both of whom have had other commitments on their schedules prior to receiving notice from Complaint Counsel and Respondents of their respective designations of Freenome's testimony and materials as trial exhibits. Additionally, neither Freenome nor its counsel had any forewarning regarding the volume of testimony

and materials that would be designated by the parties.

Under the present circumstances, Freenome respectfully requests an enlargement of the ten-day window that it has been given under the Scheduling Order and by the parties' respective notices. The language of Commission Rule 3.45(b) makes clear that ten days is the *minimum* amount of notice that Freenome, as a non-party, is entitled to receive. The four additional days that Freenome is requesting will still ensure that its motion for *in camera* treatment is filed expeditiously. On August 5, 2021, Freenome provided notice to counsel for the parties of its intention to make this Motion. See Exhibit C.

For the foregoing reasons, good cause exists for granting Freenome's Motion.

As we discussed over the phone, I attached a draft declaration related to the admissibility of Freenome documents. Please return the signed declaration by August 6, 2021, if possible, as a scanned .pdf attached to an e-mail.

Motions for *in camera* treatment of evidence to be introduced at trial must meet the strict standards set forth in 16 C.F.R. § 3.45, and explained in *In re Otto Bock Healthcare N. Am.*, 2018 WL 3491602 at *1 (July 2, 2018), and *In re 1-800 Contacts, Inc.*, 2017 FTC LEXIS 55 (Apr. 4, 2017). Motions also must be supported by a declaration or affidavit by a person qualified to explain the confidential nature of the material. *In re 1-800 Contacts, Inc.*, 2017 FTC LEXIS 55 (April 4, 2017); *In re North Texas Specialty Physicians*, 2004 FTC LEXIS 66 (Apr. 23, 2004). Each party of non-party that files a motion for *in camera* treatment shall provide one copy of the documents for which *in camera* treatment is sought to the Administrative Law Judge. As you consider whether to file a motion for *in camera* treatment of Freenome material in this matter, you may find it helpful to consult material from past administrative cases, such as, for example, this non-party motion for *in camera* treatment and the associated order from *In re Jerk*, and this order on non-parties' motions for *in camera* treatment from *Altria/Juul*.

Please note that, if you intend to file a motion, you will need credentials for the Commission's electronic filing system and to file a Notice of Appearance, which must be approved by the Office of the Secretary and can take 24 hours to issue. As such, you will need to file your Notice of Appearance at least one day prior to the day on which you intend to file your motion. I attached an e-filing system guide to assist with that process.

By this letter we are providing formal notice, pursuant to Rule 3.45(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.45(b), that Complaint Counsel intends to offer the documents and testimony referenced in the enclosed Attachment A into evidence in the administrative trial in the above-captioned matter. For your convenience, a copy of the documents and testimony will be sent to you in a separate email with an FTP link.

The administrative trial is scheduled to begin on August 24, 2021. All exhibits admitted into evidence become part of the public record unless Chief Administrative Law Judge D. Michael Chappell grants *in camera* status (i.e., non-public/confidential).

For documents or testimony that include sensitive or confidential information that you do not want on the public record, you must file a motion seeking *in camera* status or other confidentiality protections pursuant to 16 C.F.R §§ 3.45 and 4.10(g). If you do not file an *in camera* motion, your documents will not receive *in camera* treatment and may be publicly disclosed. Judge Chappell may order that materials be placed *in camera* only after finding that their public disclosure will likely result in a clearly-defined, serious injury to the person, partnership, or corporation requesting *in camera* treatment.

Motions for *in camera* treatment for evidence to be introduced at trial must meet the strict standards set forth in 16 C.F.R. § 3.45 and explained in *In re Otto Bock Healthcare N. Am.*, 2018 WL 3491602 at *1 (July 2, 2018); and *In re 1-800 Contacts, Inc.*, 2017 FTC LEXIS 55 (April 4, 2017). Motions also must be supported by a declaration or affidavit by a person qualified to explain the confidential nature of the material. *In re 1-800 Contacts, Inc.*, 2017 FTC LEXIS 55 (April 4, 2017); *In re North Texas Specialty Physicians*, 2004 FTC LEXIS 66 (Apr. 23, 2004). For your convenience, we included, as links in the cover email, an example of a third-party

motion (and the accompanying declaration or affidavit) for *in camera* treatment that was filed and granted in an FTC administrative proceeding. If you choose to move for *in camera* treatment, you must provide a copy of the document(s) for which you seek such treatment to the Administrative Law Judge.

Also, please be advised, if you intend to file an *in camera* motion, you will need credentials for the Commission's electronic filing system and a Notice of Appearance. The Notice of Appearance must be approved by the Office of the Secretary and can take up to twenty-four ("24") hours to issue. As such, you will need to file your Notice of Appearance at least one day prior to the day on which you intend to file your *in camera* motion. I have attached an e-filing checklist to assist with this process.

Please be aware that under the current Scheduling Order the deadline for filing motions seeking *in camera* treatment is August 5, 2021.
