RESOLUTION DIRECTING USE OF COMPULSORY PROCESS TO COLLECT INFORMATION REGARDING SMALL BUSINESS CREDIT REPORT PRODUCT PROVIDERS' PRACTICES

Nature and Scope of Matter:

To compile information concerning the policies, procedures, and practices of Small Business Credit Report Product ("SBCRP") providers, including the method and manner in which SBCRP providers collect, use, analyze, verify, report, and market information about entities, and SBCRP providers' marketing practices for products that purport to enable entities to monitor or supplement the information reported about them, pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 46(b).

The Federal Trade Commission hereby resolves and directs that any and all compulsory processes available to it be used in connection with this inquiry. The Federal Trade Commission specifically authorizes the filing or continuation of actions to enforce any such compulsory process after the expiration of the three-year period.

Sections 6, 9, 10, and 20 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 46, 49, 50, and 57b-1, as amended; FTC Procedures and Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 1.1 *et seq.*, and supplements thereto.
