**PETITIONERS’ UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXCEED THE WORD COUNT LIMIT IN
16 C.F.R. § 2.10(a)(1)**

Petitioners Amazon.com, Inc. (“Amazon”) and certain current and former Amazon employees¹ submit this unopposed motion requesting an Order permitting them to exceed the word count limit set forth in 16 C.F.R. § 2.10(a) for their omnibus Petition to Quash or Limit Civil Investigative Demands. 16 C.F.R. § 2.10(a) provides that any petition to limit or quash any compulsory process “shall not exceed 5,000 words.” An omnibus Petition to Quash is consistent with FTC staff’s preference for an omnibus submission. Accordingly, Amazon and these certain current and former Amazon employees move the Commission for a 10,000 word limit for their omnibus Petition. Division of Enforcement staff does not oppose this motion.
