Plaintiff FTC brings this action under Section 13(b) of the Federal Trade 24 Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 53(b), to secure a permanent injunction, rescission of 25 contracts, restitution, disgorgement of ill-gotten gains, and other equitable relief against the 26 Defendants for engaging in deceptive acts or practices in connection with the advertising of 27 mail-in rebates, in violation of Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a). 28

## JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 2. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §§ 45(a) and 53(b), and 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331, 1337(a), and 1345.
- 3. Venue is proper in this District under 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b), and (c), and 15 U.S.C. § 53(b).

# **INTRADISTRICT ASSIGNMENT**

4. The claims are based on violations that were directed at residents of San Francisco and elsewhere.

## **PLAINTIFF**

5. Plaintiff FTC is an independent agency of the United States Government created by statute. See 15 U.S.C. §§ 41-58. The FTC enforces Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), which prohibits unfair or deceptive acts or practices in or affecting commerce. The FTC, through its attorneys, may initiate federal district court proceedings to enjoin violations of the FTC Act and to secure such equitable relief, including rescission of contracts, restitution, and disgorgement of ill-gotten gains, as may be appropriate in each case. 15 U.S.C. § 53(b).

## **DEFENDANTS**

- 6. Defendant Market Development Specialists, Inc. ("MDS"), is an Indiana corporation with its principal place of business at 2510 Sterling Ave, Elkhart, IN 46516. MDS does business as "Wintergreen Systems." MDS has advertised, offered for sale, sold, and distributed products to the public, including computer-related hardware and other consumer electronics products. MDS has acted as a reseller of many products, including Hanns-G LCD monitors and Memorex Portable DVD players. MDS has distributed these products to the public through retailers of consumer electronics products, including Office Depot, PC Connection, Buy.com, PCMall, and Woot.com. To make its products more attractive to these retailers and their customers, MDS has offered numerous mail-in rebates ranging from \$20 to \$150 in value. MDS transacts or has transacted business in this District.
- 7. Defendant John Levy is the president of MDS. At all times material to this complaint, acting alone or in concert with others, he has formulated, directed, controlled, or

purchased the advertised products or did not mail them to consumers within the time promised. In fact, defendants failed to mail rebate checks to the vast majority of consumers who submitted valid requests for rebates. As a result, thousands of consumers never received a rebate check from defendants. Moreover, those minority of consumers who actually received a rebate check from defendants experienced substantial delays, including delays of ten weeks or longer.

# **VIOLATIONS OF SECTION 5 OF THE FTC ACT**

12. Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), prohibits "unfair or deceptive acts or practices in or affecting commerce."

## **COUNT I**

- 13. Through the means described in Paragraph 10, Defendants have represented, expressly or by implication, that rebate checks will be mailed to purchasers of the advertised product within approximately ten weeks after receipt of their valid requests.
- 14. The representation set forth in Paragraph 13 is false. Therefore, the making of the representation set forth in Paragraph 13 above constitutes a deceptive practice, in or affecting commerce, in violation of Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a).

#### **CONSUMER INJURY**

15. Consumers throughout the United States have suffered substantial monetary loss as a result of Defendants' unlawful acts or practices. In addition, Defendants have been unjustly enriched as a result of their unlawful practices. Absent relief by this Court, Defendants are likely to continue to injure consumers, reap unjust enrichment, and harm the public interest.

# THIS COURT'S POWER TO GRANT RELIEF

16. Section 13(b) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 53(b), empowers this Court to grant injunctive and such other relief as the Court may deem appropriate to halt and redress violations of the FTC Act. The Court, in the exercise of its equitable jurisdiction, may award other ancillary relief, including, but not limited to, rescission of contracts, restitution, and the disgorgement of ill-gotten gains, to prevent and remedy injury caused by Defendants' law violations.

## PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff FTC, pursuant to Section 13(b) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 53(b), and the Court's own equitable powers, requests that the Court:

- 1. Enter a permanent injunction to prevent future violations of the FTC Act by Defendants.
- 2. Award such relief as the Court finds necessary to redress injury to consumers resulting from Defendants' violations of the FTC Act, including, but not limited to, rescission or reformation of contracts, restitution, the refund of monies paid, and the disgorgement of ill-gotten monies; and
- 3. Award Plaintiff the costs of bringing this action, as well as such other and additional relief as the Court may determine to be just and proper.
