This Court, having considered Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission’s consent Motion to extend the Temporary Restraining Order with respect to Defendant Denny Lake and unopposed Motion to extend the Temporary Restraining Order with respect to Corporate Defendants C.C. Enterprises, Inc. and D.N. Marketing, Inc. finds that there is good cause to extend the duration of the *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order, DE 28, until May 14, 2015. The Court also finds that there is good cause to continue the Preliminary Injunction Hearing until May 14, 2015.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that, with respect to Defendants Denny Lake, C.C. Enterprises, Inc., and D.N. Marketing, Inc., the *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order entered on April 16, 2015, at 10:30 a.m. Pacific Standard Time, is extended to last until May 14, 2015, 10:30 a.m. Pacific Standard Time. In addition, with respect to the same aforementioned Defendants, the Preliminary Injunction Hearing is now scheduled for **May 13, 2015, at 4:30 p.m.**, at the United States District Courthouse, Courtroom 9B, Santa Ana, California.
