## ORDER

This Order shall only be construed to prohibit disclosure of any of the sealed information by the Office of the Clerk of the Court. This Order shall not be construed to prohibit service or other disclosure by Plaintiffs and Court-appointed Receiver, or those acting on either Plaintiffs or Receiver's behalf.

Also before the Court is Plaintiff State of Florida's *Ex Parte* Motion for Waiver of Security Requirement (Doc. S-7) and Plaintiffs' *Ex Parte* Motion for Leave to File Memorandum in Excess of Page Limitation (Doc. S-8). The former is **GRANTED**, as to be reflected in the Temporary Restraining Order. The latter, good cause having been shown, is also **GRANTED**.
