FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION'S MOTION TO HOLD ANDRIS PUKKE, PETER BAKER, AND JOHN USHER IN CONTEMPT FOR FAILING TO TURN THE SANCTUARY PARCEL OVER TO THE RECEIVER

Andris Pukke, Peter Baker, and John Usher defied this Court's repeated orders to turn over a parcel of land in Belize (the "Sanctuary Parcel") to the Receiver in this matter, resulting in significant financial harm to the *FTC v. AmeriDebt* victims. *See* DE122, 473, 571, 572, 604, 614, and 625. The Court has broad authority to compensate the FTC's and consumers' losses, including turnover orders and coercive incarceration. *United States v. United Mine Workers of Am.*, 330 U.S. 258, 303-04 (1947); *Int'l Union, United Mine Workers of Am. v. Bagwell*, 512 U.S. 821, 828 (1994); *Shillitani v. United States*, 384 U.S. 364, 370–71 (1966); *Hicks v. Feiock*, 485 U.S. 624, 632-35 (1988); *Enovative Techs., LLC v. Leor*, 110 F. Supp. 3d 633, 637 (D. Md. 2015). For the reasons detailed in the accompanying memorandum of law, the FTC, therefore,

Currently pending before the Court is a motion to consolidate this matter with the related *FTC v. Ecological Fox LLC* ("*Ecological Fox*") matter, pursuant to Rule 42, under the joint case name *In re Sanctuary Belize Litigation*.

moves the Court to order that Pukke, Baker, and Usher finally turn over the Sanctuary Parcel to the Receiver on pain of coercive incarceration.
